



Eastvale Girls Softball Association Tee Ball Rules



- Bases- 50 feet apart
- 10" soft dot ball (squishy)
- Equipment needed: glove, helmet, bat (optional)
- No coach pitch, only tee hitting.
- Batters get 5 swings off the tee to place the ball into fair territory
- Base runners may advance only ONE base at a time
 - No Stealing allowed.
- Round Robbin batting
 - Everyone in the lineup bats, then opposing team bats
 - Last batter in the line up gets to hit the "home run," meaning all runners run home.
- Once a ball is hit into fair territory, the defensive team should make the "attempt" to throw to first base.
- Defensive outs DO NOT COUNT
- Pitching rubber for defensive player placement is 30 feet.
- Defensive players should be placed at accurate positions on field, rotating every inning
- No catcher
- No more than 4 coaches allowed on the field for Defense and Offense
 - For Offense, one coach places ball on tee and guides the batters with hitting technique. Two coaches need to be 1st base coach and 3rd base coach.
 - For Defense, coaches may help throughout the field
- No umpires
- No scorekeeper
